School Team Leadership Academy

Overview:

Knowing that the core of any successful school is having a great plan to guide the continuous improvement work, this Team Academy will take deep knowledge of planning to scale by building leadership capacity within each attending school team. To accomplish this, selected school teams will engage in processes for school improvement, design implementation plans for their schools and then lead the implementation work at their sites.

Learning Outcome:

To increase teacher leadership by developing a deeper understanding of how school improvement planning helps meet the needs of students, staff and stakeholders.

Purpose:

The purpose of the *School Team Leadership Academy* is to engage school teams around:

- ❖ Data driven decision making
- ❖ The use of collaboration as a tool for PLCs
- ❖ School Improvement planning and continuous improvement
- ❖ Selection of strategies through the lens of low performing students
- ❖ School based professional development planning to support ongoing teaching and learning

Materials:

Professional resources will be provided to each team member to support the purposes of the Academy learning.

Audience:

The *School Leadership Team* will consist of school based personnel which may include a maximum of six members:

- ❖ Principal (required)*
- ❖ District support staff member (if available) to be assigned based on school focus (District/Schultz Content Specialist, Academic Coach, Cadre, other)
- ❖ School-based teacher leaders (max. 4 and may include a blend of Instructional Coaches and classroom teachers)

*Principals must have completed two or three years of Principal Academy.
